Patricia Lanza was an unsung hero. She never wore a military uniform and never received a ribbon for valor....However, if there is a ribbon for quietly changing

people's lives by listening and paying attention to what they need, and to their dreams and funding programs to make their dreams come true, she would truly have received it.

Pat was born on a military base in Texas, where her Father was in the U. S. Army as a member of its cavalry. One of her fondest memories was waking up to the morning bugle call.

Through the Lanza Investment in Veterans Empowerment, she targeted the needs of veterans. L.I.V.E. established social services to veterans in need through Family Services of Westchester and legal services through Legal Services of the Hudson Valley. She funded the Hospice and Palliative Care Breakfast as a tribute to veterans in the Hudson Valley region. Under her program, the first Stand Up for Women Veterans was held last year and became a national model. Today, the second Stand Up for Women Veterans is a reflection of her on-going commitment to those who serve. Pat knew well the sacrifice veterans and their families make

Pat Lanza cared about people who struggle against hardship. She loved to help them get beyond their hardship to maximize their potential. She admired people who persevered and strove to help them find comfort, hope and encouragement in their journey. She was a dedicated benefactor to many organizations in Westchester that help women, children and families in need. She helped community groups that work for peace and equality, and feed the homeless through her Stop and Shop Gift Card program and female veterans scholarship program because she believed that investing in education reaps great rewards

Pat Lanza brought hope wherever she went. Her legacy in Westchester County and around the world will have enduring value in the averted tragedies and re-routed lives of thousands of women and children both here and abroad.
